Krakow, Warsaw, Poznan & Gdansk 10 Days / 9 Nights

Thursday, September 10: Depart the U.S.

Friday, September 11: Upon arrival to Krakow Airport you will complete customs and immigration formalities. Then meet your Guide, who will welcome you to Krakow. Transfer to your hotel and enjoy some free time to freshen up before meeting your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner at a local restaurant. Sheraton Hotel, Krakow **(D)**

Saturday, September 12, Krakow: A morning sightseeing tour starts with a visit to Wawel Hill, viewing the Royal Castle and visiting the Royal Cathedral. Next, take a walking tour of the Old Town, where you will see the Main Market Square and Renaissance Cloth Hall and visit St. Mary's Church. In the afternoon, visit Wieliczka Salt Mines and also stroll through the Chapel of St. Kinga. Return to your hotel and freshen up before dinner with your group. Sheraton Hotel, Krakow **(B, D)**

Sunday, September 13: Auschwitz-Birkenau Today, join on a tour to Auschwitz-Birkenau, the notorious concentration camp from World War II and a UNESCO World Heritage site. In the late afternoon, return to Krakow where you have the rest of the day free to explore and find a local restaurant for dinner. Sheraton Hotel **(B)**

Monday, September 14: in Warsaw: This morning, travel to Warsaw, a 700-year-old capital that represents Polish nationhood. Your sightseeing tour here includes a drive along the famous Royal Route from magnificent Castle Square to Lazienki Park and Palace, the summer residence of the last king of Poland. Pass by the Palace of Science and Culture (known as the "wedding cake"), the Saxon Gardens, Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, Monument to the Heroes of the Warsaw Ghetto, and Barbican. Continue on to visit St. John's Cathedral and tour the crypts for an additional cost. Explore Old Market Square before checking into your hotel for dinner and your overnight stay. Sheraton Hotel, Warsaw **(B, D)**

Tuesday, September 15: Wilanow Palace: After breakfast, travel to Wilanow Palace, this splendid baroque palace, as impressive as Versailles, was built in the late 17th century as a summer residence for the King Jan Sobieski III and owned later by most important Polish noble families. The main building consisting of 3 wings, housed the oldest museum established in Poland in 1805 to preserve the memory about Sobieski family and spectacular national history moments of that time, including Battle of Vienna in 1683 against Ottoman Empire. The residence complex extended by a large garden and lake-side promenade, fortunately, avoided deeper destruction in 1939-1945. After detailed renovations in 2010-11, Wilanow Palace presents its valuable collection of

royal furniture, portraits, and China. After your visit, you will have some time to shop or relax before dinner. Sheraton Hotel, Warsaw **(B, D)**

Wednesday, September 16: Poznan: Leaving Warsaw, journey to Poznan and take a guided city tour. You will see the historical Cathedral Island, the Old Market Square and the historical Town Hall - the very landmark dubbed "the best Renaissance piece north of the Alps." Tour St. Peter and St. Paul's Cathedral to learn more about these historic sites. Then visit the Croissant Museum, you will get a chance to try one. Drive to your hotel, where you will check in for dinner and overnight stay. NHHotel, Poznan **(B, D)**

Thursday, September 17: Gdansk: Travel to Gdansk, a unique city with a spirit all its own. You'll be led by an experienced local guide who will entertain you with stories from the colorful past of Gdansk. Stroll along the city streets and come to a new appreciation of this destination once you have a complete picture of the city. Drive a short distance to your hotel, check in and settle into your room. You may like to relax or freshen up before dining with your group in the hotel restaurant. Mercure Stare Miasto Hotel, Gdansk **(B, D)**

Friday, September 18: Gdynia; Take another guided tour of Gdansk, which has renowned houses of Long Street, Neptune's fountain and other landmarks. Then it's off to the Oliwa District for a bit of relaxation before heading on to Sopot for a wander down Monciak Street. The final destination is Gdynia, where the famed WWII destroyer "Lightning" and the massive sailing ship "Gift of Pomerania" are reminders of the rich history of the Polish Navy. In the afternoon, take a panoramic tour of Sopot before heading back to Gdansk for a dinner on your own. Mercure Stare Miasto Hotel, Gdansk **(B)**

Saturday, September 19: Malbork Castle: Today, set off on a full-day tour to visit the Malbork Castle. The excursion includes a full tour of the 14th century Palace of the Grand Master, the residence of the so-called Grand Master of the Order; the St. Mary's Church, and the enormous Amber Museum. Return to your hotel and spend some time at leisure before enjoying a farewell dinner in the hotel restaurant. Mercure Stare Miasto Hotel, Gdansk **(B, D)**

Sunday, September 20: depart Gdansk: After breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport in Gdansk for your departure flight. You may do some last minute shopping at the duty free stores before flying back to the United States. **(B)**
